LEADING OFF

- The Cougars enter conference play having won four of their last six including an 8-4 win over No. 2 Texas on March 15 and a series victory against perennial regional participant East Carolina last weekend.
- Sam Cochrane's bat caught fire in a big way last week with the veteran outfielder batting .643 (9-for-14) with two doubles, a triple, a home run and four RBI to earn CAA Player of the Week honors.
- Charleston's pitching staff has been amongst the CAA's best so far this season entering the week ranked second in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and strikeout-to-walk ratio. The Cougars are also third in opposing batting average.
- CofC has deployed one of the most balanced offenses in the league thus far with five players driving in at least 10 runs led by JT Marr, Preston Hall and Trotter Harlan with 15 each. The Cougars saw a seven-game home run streak snapped on Tuesday at Georgia Southern.

MAKING A STATEMENT: The Cougars collected the eighth win over a Top-10 team in program history on March 15 with an 8-4 victory against No. 2 Texas. It was Charleston's first win over a Top-10 team since 2016 and featured the second-highest margin of victory against a Top-10 opponent in school history. Charleston then capped the week in style with its second-ever series win against ECU and first since 2005.

SLUGGIN' SAM: Grad student Sam Cochrane's bat ignited in a big way last week with the veteran outfielder stringing together four-straight multi-hit games to earn his first CAA Player of the Week award. With the effort, Cochrane raised his batting average to .333 for the season while both scoring and driving in at least one run in all four games.

CHOPPING THE WOOD: Junior Luke Wood made the most of his return to the lineup last Sunday recording his first three-hit game as a Cougar while driving in four runs with a two-run blast in the third and a two-run single in the third.

SETTING THE TONE: Charleston has enjoyed great success this season when opening the scoring carrying a 9-4 mark into the week when crossing the plate first. The Cougars are also 9-1 this season when scoring in the first inning while outscoring opponents by a 25-4 margin in the opening frame.

BRINGING THEM HOME: The Cougars have accumulated 31 RBI in 50 opportunities with a runner on third and less than two outs this season for a combined 62.0% conversion rate. Trotter Harlan leads the way with six RBI in that situation followed by Preston Hall and Tyler Sorrentino with four each. Cam Dean, JT Marr and Joseph Mershon have each accounted for three RBI with a runner on third and less than two outs.

MR. CONSISTENCY: Junior Trotter Harlan has been an on-base machine so far this season with an on-base percentage of .472 through 21 games. The Fountain Inn, S.C. native has reached base in 31 of the last 33 games dating back to last season and is currently 21st in the nation with 20 walks.

BULLPEN KINGS: William Privette, Reed Parris and Luke Vaks have been superb out of the 'pen thus far combining for a 2-0 record, three saves, a 1.13 ERA and .182 batting average against in 40 innings pitched. Privette has been nothing short of spectacular leading the CAA and ranking 14th nationally with a 0.83 ERA in 21.2 innings of work while Reed Parris sports a WHIP of 0.81 in 16 frames.

JT ON A TEAR: Junior transfer JT Marr has been a steady force in his first season as a Cougar reaching base in all 21 games while leading the team in batting average, hits and slugging percentage. He also leads the team with nine multi-hit games while his 30 hits rank second in the league.

WEEKEND CLOSER: Connor Campbell has been superb at the back end of the weekend rotation entering the week with a 3-0 record with a 2.49 ERA and 21 strikeouts in 25.1 innings of work. The senior southpaw leads the team with three quality starts and is currently eighth in the CAA in ERA while also holding opponents to a .237 batting average.

LEAVING IT LATE: Charleston's bats have been especially productive in the latter innings so far this season with 69 of the Cougars' 124 runs (55.2%) crossing the plate in the fifth inning or later, with 39 of those runs coming in the seventh inning or later.

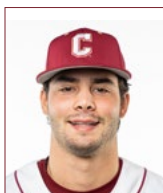
