- The Cougars secured their third straight home sweep in CAA play last weekend to take a 2.5 game lead at the top of the conference standings halfway through the league schedule.
- Sophomore William Privette has been nothing short of spectacular out of the 'pen this season entering the weekend ranked second in the nation with a 0.93 ERA while leading the CAA with seven saves. He earned both a win and a save in 4.2 shutout innings over two appearances in the sweep of William & Mary to earn CAA Pitcher of the Week accolades.
- Charleston's offense has not shied from the big moments of late with five comeback victories in the Cougars' last seven games including three walk-off victories.
- The Cougars have been lethal with two outs this season accounting for nearly 38 percent of their total run production with two men down.
- Graduate student Sam Cochrane has been swinging a red-hot bat over the last 21 games batting .342 in that span to raise his season batting average from .148 to .290. The Ocala, Fla. native has also driven in 13 runs in the last 10 games including six in the series sweep of James Madison.

STELLAR START: Charleston is off to an outstanding start in conference play this season entering the week with a 2.5 game lead over UNCW after sweeping William & Mary this weekend. With that sweep, the Cougars have started 9-0 at home in CAA play for the third time since joining the league in 2014.

CARDIAC COUGARS: The Cougars have been extremely tough to put away over the last two weeks with five come-from-behind victories in their last seven games including a trio of walk-off wins. After posting back-to-back walk-off wins to secure a sweep of James Madison on April 9 and 10, the Cougars delivered their fourth walk-off of the season last Saturday to clinch the series win against William & Mary. Charleston has also rallied from a four-run deficit in back-to-back games against William & Mary and USC Upstate.

SLUGGIN' SAM: Graduate student Sam Cochrane has been superb over the past month reaching safely in 18 of the last 20 games to raise his batting average from .148 to .305. The Ocala, Fla. native has posted seven multi-hit games in that span while driving in 15 runs over the last 10 games.

SETTING THE TONE: Charleston has enjoyed great success in the opening frame this season combining for a .320 batting average while outscoring its opponents, 36-5, in the first inning. The Cougars are 13-3 when plating at least one run in the opening frame.

MAKING AN IMPACT: Senior Tanner McCallister has delivered in a big way over the last week with clutch home runs in back-to-back games. The Roebuck, S.C. native marked his first home run of the season in style last Sunday against William & Mary with a pinch-hit, game-tying homer in the Cougars' 7-5 comeback win. He launched a two-run bomb on Tuesday to spark Charleston's four-run rally with two outs in the ninth at USC Upstate.

CAA STUDS: Sam Cochrane, Trotter Harlan and JT Marr have been outstanding in the first half of the CAA schedule combining for 41 of the Cougars' 75 RBI thus far. Five Cougars are currently hitting at least .300 in league play led by Cam Dean's .333 clip.

TWO-OUT DAMAGE: The Cougars have been ruthless with two outs on the scoreboard this season accounting for more than a third (37.9%) of their total run output with two down. Charleston has totaled 85 runs with two outs this season scoring at least two runs with two down in 20 of 36 games thus far.

MR. CONSISTENCY: Junior Trotter Harlan has been an on-base machine so far this season with an on-base percentage of .437 through 36 games. The Fountain Inn, S.C. native has reached base in 42 of the last 48 games dating back to last season and is currently second in the CAA with 27 walks.

BULLPEN KINGS: William Privette and Reed Parris have been superb out of the 'pen thus far combining for a 7-0 record, seven saves, a 1.47 ERA and .187 batting average against in 67.1 innings pitched. Privette has been nothing short of spectacular ranking second nationally with a 0.93 ERA in 38.2 innings of work while Reed Parris sports a WHIP of 0.98 in 28.2 frames.

MASHING MARR: Junior transfer JT Marr has been a steady force in his first season as a Cougar reaching base in all but two games while leading the team in batting average, hits, RBI and slugging percentage. He is also tied for the team lead in homers with six while pacing the Cougars with 13 multi-hit games.

WEEKEND CLOSER: Connor Campbell has been superb at the back end of the weekend rotation entering the week with a 3-0 record with a 3.22 ERA and 34 strikeouts in 44.2 innings of work. The senior southpaw leads the team with three quality starts and is currently ninth in the CAA in ERA while walking only 11 batters thus far.

DEFENDING THE RAMPARTS: The Cougars have played their best baseball in the friendly confines of Patriots Point this season entering the week tied for the best record (20-4) through the first 24 home games in program history. The 2022 campaign marks the 22nd season with at least 20 home victories in school history.


