# **LEADING OFF**

- The Cougars have been rolling over the last two weeks having won 10 of their last 12 including nine straight in CAA action entering the weekend.
- Junior Ty Good delivered a sensational outing in the series opener against Elon last Friday allowing one earned run and scattering six hits across seven innings to earn his sixth win of the season. The Rock Hill, S.C. native struck out a career-high 11 batters while not surrendering a walk to earn his first career CAA Pitcher of the Week honors.
- Sophomore William Privette has been virtually untouchable out of the 'pen this season entering the weekend ranked second in the nation in ERA (0.86), ninth in hits allowed per nine innings (5.4), 18th in WHIP (0.91) and 19th in saves (8). The lanky right-hander has struck out 55 batters in only 41.2 innings of work and was named to the NCBWA's Midseason Stopper of the Year Watch List on Wednesday.
- Junior Trotter Harlan has been a consistent force in the lineup this season reaching base safely in all but four games while leading the team in on-base percentage (.431), RBI (34) and stolen bases (16). He also leads the CAA with 29 walks.
- The Cougars have been lethal with two outs this season accounting for 36 percent of their total run production with two men down.

**CLASS OF THE CAA:** Charleston has put together an outstanding season in conference play thus far entering the weekend with a 3.5 game lead over UNCW after delivering its fourth league sweep of the campaign at Elon. The Cougars' four sweeps in conference action are tied for the program's second-most since joining the league and are one shy of equaling the 2015 team's total of five.

**CARDIAC COUGARS:** The Cougars have been extremely tough to put away over the last couple weeks with five come-from-behind victories in a seven-game span including a trio of walk-off wins. After posting back-to-back walk-off wins to secure a sweep of James Madison on April 9 and 10, the Cougars delivered their fourth walk-off of the season on April 16 to clinch the series win against William & Mary. Charleston has also rallied from a four-run deficit in back-to-back games against William & Mary and USC Upstate.

**SNUFFING OUT THE PHOENIX:** The Cougars' pitching staff delivered perhaps its most complete weekend of the season in the sweep of Elon holding the Phoenix to five runs (four earned) on 17 hits with only four of those going for extra bases. In 27 innings of work, the Cougars surrendered only seven walks while recording 29 strikeouts.

**SETTING THE TONE:** Charleston has enjoyed great success in the opening frame this season combining for a .315 batting average while outscoring its opponents, 41-8, in the first inning. The Cougars are 14-4 when plating at least one run in the opening frame.

**ROOKIE RAKING:** Freshman Tyler Sorrentino had a weekend to remember at Elon accounting for seven of the Cougars' 19 RBI including a career-high four in an 11-2 win series-opening win. The speedy outfielder has been superb in CAA play thus far driving in 14 runs in 15 games while leading the team with a .328 batting average against league opponents.

**CAA STUDS:** Sam Cochrane, Trotter Harlan and JT Marr have been outstanding through the first 15 games of the CAA schedule combining for 48 of the Cougars' 94 RBI thus far. Six Cougars are currently hitting at least .295 in league play led by Tyler Sorrentino's .328 clip.

**TWO-OUT DAMAGE:** The Cougars have been ruthless with two outs on the scoreboard this season accounting for more than a third (36.0%) of their total run output with two down. Charleston has totaled 91 runs with two outs this season scoring at least two runs with two down in 20 of 40 games thus far.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** Charleston passed a big test on the road last week with flying colors posting a perfect 4-0 mark at USC Upstate and Elon to improve to 6-9 away from Patriots Point this season. The Cougars' sweep of Elon was their second all-time against the Phoenix and first since 2005. Both sweeps of Elon have been on the road.

**BULLPEN KINGS:** William Privette and Reed Parris have been superb out of the 'pen thus far combining for a 8-0 record, eight saves, a 1.36 ERA and .181 batting average against in 73 innings pitched. Privette has been nothing short of spectacular ranking second nationally with a 0.86 ERA in 41.2 innings of work while Reed Parris sports a WHIP of 0.99 in 31.1 frames.

**TWO-WAY TERROR:** Freshman Cole Mathis put his two-way talent on full display at Elon last weekend striking out five batters in four shutout innings across two relief appearances while also marking his first collegiate home run with a two-run shot on Sunday. For his efforts, Mathis was named the CAA Rookie of the Week on Monday.

**MAKING THEIR MARKS:** Junior Will Baumhofer and freshman Patrick Sanchez each took a personal highlight home on Tuesday evening with both hitting their first collegiate home run against Coastal Carolina. Baumhofer marked his first collegiate hit with a lead-off homer int he sixth and Sanchez launched a two-run shot in the eighth.

**DEFENDING THE RAMPARTS:** The Cougars have played their best baseball in the friendly confines of Patriots Point this season entering the weekend tied for the best record (20-5) through the first 25 home games in program history. The 2022 campaign marks the 22nd season with at least 20 home victories in school history.




