- The Cougars enter the week in a five-way tie for first in the CAA after two weekends of conference play. Charleston dropped two of three to the Pride this weekend despite holding a lead in each game, picking up its first win at Hofstra since 2014 on Saturday.
- Junior Trotter Harlan has been a force in the lineup for the Cougars this season entering Tuesday's game leading the team in on-base percentage (.442) while ranking second in the league with 24 walks thus far.
- Sophomore William Privette has been simply superb out of the bullpen so far this season entering the week ranked third in the nation with a 0.63 ERA in 28.2 innings of work. The 6-foot-6 right-hander is currently tied for the CAA lead with five saves.
- The Cougars have deployed one of the most balanced offenses in the league thus far with five players driving in at least 13 runs led by JT Marr, Preston Hall and Trotter Harlan who have combined for 62 of CofC's 146 RBI to date.

**MAKING A STATEMENT:** Charleston opened the CAA schedule with a bang sweeping preseason favorite Northeastern for the first time in program history. It was the Cougars' fourth series sweep to open conference action since joining the CAA and saw CofC outscore the Huskies, 28-13.

**DESIGNATED DON:** Senior Donald Hansis possesses without doubt one of the most dangerous bats in the Cougar lineup entering the week ranked second on the team with five home runs after homering in back-to-back games at Hofstra. Nine of Hansis' 12 hits this season have gone for extra bases.

**FRESHMAN FIREBALLER:** Freshman right-hander Daniel Brooks delivered perhaps his best performance of the season in game one of Saturday's doubleheader holding Hofstra to five hits in six scoreless innings of work. Brooks finished with six strikeouts and collected his second collegiate win while stranding a trio of Pride in scoring position.

**SETTING THE TONE:** Charleston has enjoyed great success in the opening frame this season combining for a .339 batting average while outscoring its opponents, 32-4, in the first inning. The Cougars are 11-2 when plating at least one run in the opening frame.

**DEBUTING IN STYLE:** Sophomore Brody Hopkins made his first collegiate appearance as a pitcher last Tuesday at Charlotte, striking out two and walking one in two scoreless innings of work.

**TWO-OUT DAMAGE:** The Cougars have been ruthless with two outs on the scoreboard this season accounting for more than a third (34.3%) of their total run output with two down. Charleston has totaled 58 runs with two outs this season scoring at least two runs with two down in 14 of 28 games thus far.

MR. CONSISTENCY: Junior Trotter Harlan has been an on-base machine so far this season with an on-base percentage of .442 through 28 games. The Fountain Inn, S.C. native has reached base in 36 of the last 40 games dating back to last season and is currently second in the CAA with 24 walks.

**BULLPEN KINGS:** William Privette and Reed Parris have been superb out of the 'pen thus far combining for a 3-0 record, five saves, a 1.03 ERA and .174 batting average against in 52.1 innings pitched. Privette has been nothing short of spectacular leading the CAA and ranking third nationally with a 0.63 ERA in 28.2 innings of work while Reed Parris sports a WHIP of 0.72 in 23.2 frames.

**JT ON A TEAR:** Junior transfer JT Marr has been a steady force in his first season as a Cougar reaching base in all but one game while leading the team in batting average, hits, RBI and slugging percentage. He is also tied for third with four home runs while pacing the Cougars with 11 multi-hit games.

**ROOKIE RAKING:** Redshirt freshman Preston Hall delivered several key hits in the weekend sweep of Northeastern en route to capturing his first career CAA Rookie of the Week accolades. The Gastonia, N.C. homered in back-to-back games on Saturday and Sunday including a goahead solo shot in Saturday's 14-9 win. He currently leads the team with six home runs and is third with 19 RBI.

**WEEKEND CLOSER:** Connor Campbell has been superb at the back end of the weekend rotation entering the week with a 3-0 record with a 2.86 ERA and 26 strikeouts in 34.2 innings of work. The senior southpaw leads the team with three quality starts and is currently sixth in the CAA in ERA while walking only seven batters thus far.

**STARTING A TREND:** The week of March 14-20 marked a turning point for the 2022 Cougars it seems. It was a week that not only saw CofC secure their first series victory against ECU since 2005, but also the eighth win over a Top-10 team in program history with an 8-4 victory against No. 2 Texas on March 15.






