#### **LEADING OFF**

- The Cougars have been rolling over the last six weeks having won 16 of their last 18 overall including 14 of the last 15 in CAA play to secure the program's second CAA regular season title last Sunday.
- Freshman outfielder Tyler Sorrentino paced the Cougars with a trio of two-hit games in the series win at UNCW to earn his second CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the season.
- The quartet of Trotter Harlan, Sam Cochrane, JT Marr and Tyler Sorrentino have been absolutely lethal to this point in conference play combining for more than 57 percent of the Cougars' RBI in league play this season.
- Charleston's pitching staff has been dominant over the last three weekends combining for a 1.69 ERA in a trio of series wins including two sweeps against Elon, Delaware and UNCW to climb to 16th in the nation in team ERA (3.77).
- Sophomore William Privette has been lights out this season out of the bullpen currently ranking second in the nation in ERA (0.72), sixth in hits allowed per nine innings (5.26), sixth in saves (11) and 13th in WHIP (0.89).

**CLASS OF THE CAA:** Charleston has put together a dominant performance in conference play so far this season, clinching its second CAA regular season championship in program history over the weekend. The Cougars are the first Division I school in a single-division conference to clinch the regular season title this season and have won the second-most CAA games (18) in school history.

**TAKING HIS CHANCES:** Jared Kirven has made the most of his opportunities of late posting a multi-hit game in each of his last four starts. He has collected nine hits in 15 at-bats over that span while driving in seven runs. Kirven plated a career-high four runs in Tuesday's win over Clemson.

**NEXT MAN UP:** Trey Pooser and Emmett Bice have stepped up in a big way over the last two weekends combining to allow only two earned runs on 16 hits in 21.2 innings of work filling in as the Cougars' Saturday and Sunday starters. Bice spun 7.1 shutout innings in his first career start against Delaware to earn CAA Co-Pitcher of the Week accolades while Pooser tossed six shutout innings this past Saturday at UNCW.

**SHUTTING 'EM DOWN:** The Cougars' pitching staff has been outstanding over the last three weekends combining for a 1.69 ERA, 72 strikeouts and a .178 opponent's batting average in three series wins - including two sweeps - against Elon, Delaware and UNCW. They held Elon to four earned runs on 17 hits in a series sweep in North Carolina before limiting Delaware's potent lineup to five earned runs on 16 hits.

**RIVALRY ROAD:** Charleston sealed the program's second CAA regular season title in style over the weekend picking up the school's first-ever series win at UNCW with dominating victories on Saturday and Sunday. The Cougars held UNCW to six earned runs on 18 hits while combining for a .340 batting average as a team. Tyler Sorrentino collected a team-high six hits to pace a group of four players with at least five base knocks in the series.

**SETTING THE TONE:** Charleston has enjoyed great success in the opening frame this season combining for a .321 batting average while outscoring its opponents, 46-8, in the first inning. The Cougars are 17-4 when plating at least one run in the opening frame.

**ROOKIE RAKING:** Freshman Tyler Sorrentino has been outstanding this season but has played particularly well in conference play. He enters the week ranked second in the CAA with a .360 batting average against league opponents and has posted six straight two-hit games. The West Essex, N.J. native paced the Cougars with six hits and four runs scored this past weekend to earn his second CAA Rookie of the Week accolades of the season.

**COMING UP GOOD:** Friday night starter Ty Good has set the tone for the Cougars over the last five weekends compiling a 4-1 record with a 2.30 ERA during that stretch. The Rock Hill, S.C. native has allowed eight earned runs on just 19 hits across more than 31 innings of work in that span. He struck out a career-high 11 batters in 7.1 innings of work at Elon on April 22 to earn his first career CAA Pitcher of the Week honors.

**TWO-OUT DAMAGE:** The Cougars have been ruthless with two outs on the scoreboard this season accounting for more than a third (34.7%) of their total run output with two down. Charleston has totaled 107 runs with two outs this season scoring at least two runs with two down in 25 of 47 games thus far.

**BULLPEN KINGS:** William Privette and Reed Parris have been superb out of the 'pen thus far combining for a 8-0 record, 11 saves, a 1.37 ERA and a .179 batting average against in 85.2 innings pitched. Privette has been nothing short of spectacular ranking second nationally with a 0.72 ERA in 49.2 innings of work while Reed Parris sports a WHIP of 0.97 in 36 frames.

**SLAMMING THE DOOR:** The Cougars have been virtually impossible to take down in the later innings this season carrying a perfect 28-0 record when leading after six innings. Charleston has outscored their opponents by a 147-90 margin in the sixth inning or later this spring.

**DEFENDING THE RAMPARTS:** The Cougars have played their best baseball in the friendly confines of Patriots Point this season entering the weekend with the best record (23-5) through the first 28 home games in program history. The 2022 campaign marks the 22nd season with at least 20 home victories in school history.
