LEADING OFF

- The Cougars have been rolling since early April winning 19 of their last 21 overall including 14 of the last 15 in CAA play to secure the program's second CAA regular season title.
- Charleston's offense has been firing on all cylinders over the last 15 games scoring 131 runs and combining for a .313 batting average in that span. Joseph Mershon and Tyler Sorrentino lead the way in that span combining for 29 RBI and batting .392 and .355, respectively.
- The quartet of Trotter Harlan, Sam Cochrane, JT Marr and Tyler Sorrentino have been absolutely lethal to this point in conference play combining for more than 57 percent of the Cougars' RBI in league play this season.
- Sophomore William Privette has been lights out this season out of the bullpen currently leading the nation in ERA (0.69) while ranking fifth in hits allowed per nine innings (4.99), sixth in saves (12) and ninth in WHIP (0.84).

CLASS OF THE CAA: Charleston has put together a dominant performance in conference play this season, clinching its second CAA regular season championship in program history with a series win at UNCW. The Cougars were the first Division I school in a single-division conference to clinch the regular season title this season and have won the second-most CAA games (18) in school history.

SOPHOMORE STUD: William Privette has established himself as one of the top relief arms in both the CAA and the nation this season entering the weekend leading all NCAA Division I pitchers with a 0.69 ERA while ranking fifth in hits allowed per nine innings (4.99), sixth in saves (12) and ninth in WHIP (0.84). The Chapin, S.C. native has fanned 71 batters in 52.1 innings of work and figures to be in the conversation for the prestigious Stopper of the Year award. Ten of Privette's 12 saves this season have come in outings spanning two or more innings.

MASHING MERSH: Joseph Mershon has been on a tear over the last 15 games batting .392 with two home runs and 12 RBI to raise his season batting average from .242 to .296. The junior second baseman delivered in a big way last weekend against Charleston Southern driving in six runs including four in a 3-for-4 effort on Sunday.

RETURN OF THE MAC: Tanner McCallister delivered several key hits over the last two games driving in eight runs on only three hits. The Senior first baseman went 2-for-4 in Sunday's win over Charleston Southern with a career-high five RBI before lacing a bases-clearing, three-run double on Tuesday against The Citadel.

NEXT MAN UP: Trey Pooser and Emmett Bice have stepped up in a big way over the last two weekends in league play combining to allow only two earned runs on 16 hits in 21.2 innings of work filling in as the Cougars' Saturday and Sunday starters. Bice spun 7.1 shutout innings in his first career start against Delaware to earn CAA Co-Pitcher of the Week accolades while Pooser tossed six shutout innings this past Saturday at UNCW.

SHUTTING 'EM DOWN: The Cougars' pitching staff has been outstanding over the last three CAA weekends combining for a 1.69 ERA, 72 strikeouts and a .178 opponent's batting average in three series wins - including two sweeps - against Elon, Delaware and UNCW. They held Elon to four earned runs on 17 hits in a series sweep in North Carolina before limiting Delaware's potent lineup to five earned runs on 16 hits.

TAKING HIS CHANCES: Jared Kirven has made the most of his opportunities of late posting a multi-hit game in five of his last six starts. He has collected 13 hits in 26 at-bats over that span while driving in seven runs. Kirven plated a career-high four runs in the 7-5 win over Clemson on May 10.

RIVALRY ROAD: Charleston sealed the program's second CAA regular season title in style on May 6-8 picking up the school's first-ever series win at UNCW with dominating victories on Saturday and Sunday. The Cougars held UNCW to six earned runs on 18 hits while combining for a .340 batting average as a team. Tyler Sorrentino collected a team-high six hits to pace a group of four players with at least five base knocks in the series.

SETTING THE TONE: Charleston has enjoyed great success in the opening frame this season combining for a .320 batting average while outscoring its opponents, 48-9, in the first inning. The Cougars are 19-4 when plating at least one run in the opening frame.

EARNING HIS PLACE: Senior Cam Dean has made it virtually impossible to exclude him from the lineup this season cementing himself as the Cougars' everyday shortstop while entering the weekend ranked second on the team in both batting average (.313) and doubles (11). The Surfside Beach, S.C. native has been one of Charleston's most consistent bats in clutch situations leading the team with a .383 average with runners in scoring position while ranking second with 12 two-out RBI.

SETTING 'EM UP: Reed Parris has carved out a key role as the Cougars' primary set-up man since transferring from Division II Mount Olive entering the weekend with a 5-0 record and a 2.45 ERA in 36.2 innings of work of the 'pen. The Kinston, N.C. native has issued only nine walks this season and sports a WHIP of 1.02.

ROOKIE RAKING: Tyler Sorrentino has hit the ground running in his first season of collegiate baseball leading the team with 20 multi-games while equaling the Cougars' rookie record with four triples thus far. The West Essex, New Jersey native has been lethal in CAA play entering the regular season's final week ranked second in the league with a .360 batting average against conference opponents. He has twice been named the CAA Rookie of the Week and marked his first collegiate home run with a grand slam last Saturday at Charleston Southern.

TWO-OUT DAMAGE: The Cougars have been ruthless with two outs on the scoreboard this season accounting for more than a third (36.0%) of their total run output with two down. Charleston has totaled 125 runs with two outs this season scoring at least two runs with two down in 29 of 50 games thus far.

SLAMMING THE DOOR: The Cougars have been virtually impossible to take down in the later innings this season carrying a perfect 31-0 record when leading after six innings. Charleston has outscored their opponents by a 163-112 margin in the sixth inning or later this spring.

DEFENDING THE RAMPARTS: The Cougars played their best baseball in the friendly confines of Patriots Point this season posting a 25-5 record at home while equaling the program's single-season record for home winning percentage (.833). The 2022 campaign marks the 22nd season with at least 20 home victories in school history.

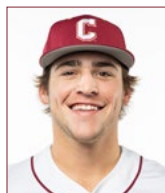
