- The Cougars have been rolling over the last several weeks having won 13 of their last 15 including 12 straight in CAA play entering the weekend.
- Junior Emmett Bice shined in his first career start last Sunday striking out five and holding Delaware to three singles in seven and one-third innings of work to earn his second collegiate win. For his efforts, Bice was named CAA Co-Pitcher of the Week.
- The quartet of Trotter Harlan, Sam Cochrane, JT Marr and Tyler Sorrentino have been absolutely lethal to this point in conference play combining for 71 of the Cougars' 119 RBI through the first 18 games of league action.
- Charleston completed the first-ever undefeated home conference schedule in program history over the weekend finishing its home CAA slate with a perfect 12-0 mark with sweeps of Northeastern, William & Mary, JMU and Delaware.
- Junior JT Marr has been a consistent force in the batting order this season entering the weekend leading the Cougars in batting average, hits and slugging percentage and is tied for first with six home runs.

**CLASS OF THE CAA:** Charleston has put together an outstanding season in conference play thus far entering the weekend with a five-game lead over second-place Hofstra with three weekends left in the regular season. The Cougars became the first team to clinch a spot in the CAA Tournament over the weekend and are closing in on the program's first regular season title since 2015. Charleston has posted five series sweeps through six weekends in league play which is tied with the 2015 team for the most since CofC joined the league in 2014.

**NEXT MAN UP:** Trey Pooser and Emmett Bice stepped up in a big way last weekend with the Cougars down two weekend starters for the first time this season. The duo combined for one earned run on seven hits and seven strikeouts in 10.2 innings of work on Saturday and Sunday against Delaware. Bice delivered the performance of the weekend - and perhaps the season - on Sunday tossing seven and one-third shutout innings in his first career start.

**SHUTTING 'EM DOWN:** The Cougars' pitching staff has been outstanding over the last two weekends combining for a 1.50 ERA, 50 strikeouts and a .171 opponent's batting average in sweeps of Elon and Delaware. Charleston has allowed a total of nine earned runs on 33 hits - nine of them for extra bases - over the last two weekends. After holding Elon to five runs on 17 hits on Apr. 22-24, the Cougars limited Delaware's potent lineup to five earned runs on 16 hits.

**MAKING THE MOST OF IT:** Landon Choboy, Tanner McCallister and Jared Kirven each made the most of their chances this past weekend combining for 14 hits in 21 at-bats in the sweep of Delaware. Choboy and McCallister each delivered the first four-hit game of their respective careers on Friday combining for four RBI and five runs scored in CofC's 13-2 win. Kirven turned in his eighth career three-hit game on Sunday launching his fifth collegiate home run and scoring a career-high three runs.

**SETTING THE TONE:** Charleston has enjoyed great success in the opening frame this season combining for a .322 batting average while outscoring its opponents, 45-8, in the first inning. The Cougars are 16-4 when plating at least one run in the opening frame.

**ROOKIE RAKING:** Freshman Tyler Sorrentino has been superb in conference play this season leading the team with a .342 batting average and is tied for second on the team with 18 RBI in 18 league games. The speedy outfielder had a weekend to remember at Elon accounting for seven of the Cougars' 19 RBI including a career-high four in an 11-2 win series-opening win.

**COMING UP GOOD:** Friday night starter Ty Good has set the tone for the Cougars over the last four weekends compiling a 4-0 record with a 1.78 ERA during that stretch. The Rock Hill, S.C. native has allowed five earned runs on just 15 hits across more than 25 innings in that span. He struck out a career-high 11 batters in 7.1 innings of work at Elon on April 22 to earn his first career CAA Pitcher of the Week honors.

**TWO-OUT DAMAGE:** The Cougars have been ruthless with two outs on the scoreboard this season accounting for more than a third (34.7%) of their total run output with two down. Charleston has totaled 97 runs with two outs this season scoring at least two runs with two down in 22 of 43 games thus far.

**BULLPEN KINGS:** William Privette and Reed Parris have been superb out of the 'pen thus far combining for a 8-0 record, nine saves, a 1.38 ERA and a .182 batting average against in 78.1 innings pitched. Privette has been nothing short of spectacular ranking third nationally with a 0.81 ERA in 44.1 innings of work while Reed Parris sports a WHIP of 1.00 in 34 frames.

**MAKING THEIR MARKS:** Junior Will Baumhofer and freshman Patrick Sanchez each took a personal highlight home on April 26 with both hitting their first collegiate home run against Coastal Carolina. Baumhofer marked his first collegiate hit with a lead-off homer int he sixth and Sanchez launched a two-run shot in the eighth.

**DEFENDING THE RAMPARTS:** The Cougars have played their best baseball in the friendly confines of Patriots Point this season entering the weekend with the best record (23-5) through the first 28 home games in program history. The 2022 campaign marks the 22nd season with at least 20 home victories in school history.


